

What belongs where?

Survey of accurate sorting



Bulky refuse

Bulky single pieces which do not fit in the refuse ton, as such:

- **furniture:** cupboards, sofas, chairs, tables
- **living:** mattresses carpets, lamps, mirrors, wooden blinds
- **recreation, hobby:** aquariums, bikes, large toys
- **household:** paddling pools, buggies, pet cages, baskets, washing spins

This does not belong to the bulky refuse:

- building sites material such as: windows, doors, other building material
- cartons
- small pieces
- electronic equipment

Please notice:

- Rests and contamination has to be cleaned up and tidied away.



Hazardous waste

toxic refuse, such as:

- **chemical**
acids and alkali, pesticides, turpentine, colours and glue (not hardened up)
- **batteries, fluorescent lamps**
rechargeable batteries, household batteries, button cells, car batteries, energy saving lamps, neon lamps
- **refuse with oil**
motor oil, grease, oil drained cleaning cloth, oil filters, brake fluid

Please notice:

- Liquid waste has to be transported in closes boxes.
- Electrical equipments (fridges, televisions, handy...) are as well hazardous waste, which has to be disposed over the collecting points in Nordhorn, Isterberg and Wilsum.



Garden refuse:

Vegetable refuse from house and garden, such as:

- cuttings of trees and bushes
- lawn cuttings
- plants

Not into the garden refuse belongs:

- "rustic fences"
- shelves

Please notice at the street collection:

- Branches have to be tied up, t ribs are allowed to have a size of 15 cm and a length of max. 2 m.



Other refuse

All types of other refuse can be disposed over the refuse collecting points in the administrative district.

What belongs where?

Yellow refuse sack

Packaging of plastic, metal and combination with the "green point", as such:

- aluminium foil
- crisps bags
- one-way food dishes
- paint bucket and pots , emptied of leavings
- yoghurt pots
- tins
- marge pots
- metal tubes
- plastic bags
- cream pots
- screw closures
- shampoo bottles
- aerosol cans
- washing-up liquid bottles
- polystyrene packaging (for example of electrical equipment)
- PAH
- vacuum packaging
- toothpaste tubes

This does not belong into the sack:

- nappies
- left over food
- commodities of plastic (for instance tooth brushes)
- paper
- packaging of building material

Please notice:

- Packaging has to be disposed without contents.
- Yellow refuse sacks can not be used as residual waste or sacks for transport.



Survey of accurate sorting

Paper barrel

packaging and printed papers made of paper and cardboard, as such:

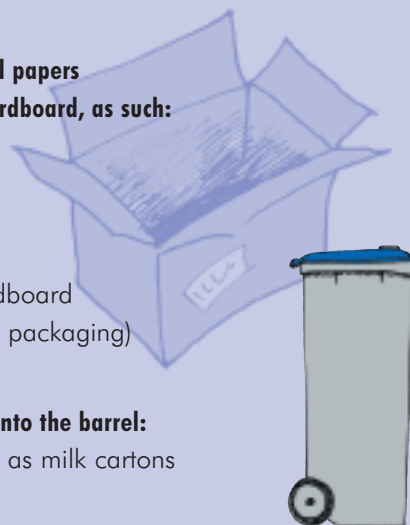
- envelopes
- books
- cardboard boxes
- prospects
- packaging of cardboard (for instance noodle packaging)
- newspapers

This does not belong into the barrel:

- tetra packs - such as milk cartons
- rests of wallpaper

Please notice:

- Huge amounts of paper/cardboard, which does not fit in the paper ton, has to be disposed at the refuse- place.



Glass container

bottles and other packaging out of glass, for instance

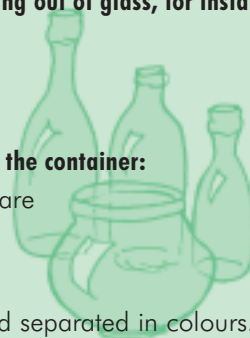
- bottles
- preserving jars
- jam jars

This does not belong into the container:

- bottles out of stoneware
- window grate

Please notice:

- Bottles to be disposed separated in colours.
- Blue glass has to be disposed in the green glass container.



What belongs where?

Rest refuse (grey ton)

Used articles of daily use of all types - and not to be utilisable rests, as such:

- contents of the ashtray
- hardened up rests of colours
- baking paper
- felt tip pens
- films
- crockery
- broken glass
- incandescent lamps – no energy saving lamps
- household cloth
- rests of wood
- sanitary products
- rubbish
- toys
- sheet protectors
- shavings of wood
- paper tissues
- video tapes or cassettes
- left over food
- soiled packaging
- vacuum cleaner bags
- wallpaper rests
- rests of cloth
- nappies
- tooth brushes

This does not belong in the rest refuse:

- Electrical equipments, such as: handy
- liquid waste
- hazardous waste

Please notice:

- Waste, which does not fit in the grey ton, has got to be disposed in a chargeable grey refuse sack or over the refuse receiving office
